#### To become a member you must:

- Have a full birth certificate (not a short version)
- Be a US Citizen
- Have a social security number/card
- Be in good shape and able to hike in rough terrain
- Be 18 – 25 years old
- Be subject to a criminal background check
- Have your own room, board and transportation
- Be available to serve Monday through Wednesday– 3/10 hour days

#### Benefits:

- \$800 Monthly Living Allowance
- After completing 675 service hours will be eligible for an Education Award of \$2,200
- Will receive training in forest conservation and other related skills
